It is the policy of Waddington & Ledger Ltd to conduct its printing operations in a safe and responsible manner. Our commitment to pollution prevention and to protecting and enhancing the environment will be applied via a programme of continual improvement.

Our aims will be achieved through:

- Meeting or exceeding the requirements of:- environmental legislation; other legislation and regulations that may have an impact on the environmental aspects; other committed voluntary requirements; keeping abreast of the latest knowledge and technology applicable to our industry, referring where appropriate to the British Printing Industries Federation
- Working with suppliers and contractors to ensure that all products, materials and services maintain the environmental standards of Waddington & Ledger and its customers
- Being able to supply sustainable materials from FSC and PEFC sources. To that end, we are committed to implementing and maintaining FSC and PEFC Chain of Custody registration
- Using paper and packaging materials from manufacturers who operate sustainable forestry management techniques
- Carefully choosing materials and products to use in our processes that minimise risks to the environment
- Maintaining effective systems for the correct identification, segregation and storage of different categories of waste materials prior to removal by registered waste disposal or reprocessing companies
- Training employees in environmental risk awareness and correct working practices in order to minimise impact and to reduce waste
- Eliminating or minimising environmental impacts of any emissions or effluents from our processes
- Seeking opportunities to improve energy efficiency and reduce the consumption of non-renewable resources
- Setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets
- Working with the local Green Business Network to share in good practice
- Being a responsible neighbour and member of the community, ensuring that none of our activities or processes impinge adversely on our immediate environment or our neighbours
